

SISTEMA TRESS 2009 SUA VERSION

On March 5th, 2009, the SUA (Sistema Único de Autodeterminación in Spanish) 3.2.5 supplement was published in the IMSS (Instituto Mexicano del Seguro Social) Internet site.

The following items are the most relevant and concern our clients at Grupo Tress Internacional:

Adaptations to INFONAVIT:

1. There is an increment to the amount of Housing Damage Insurance (*Seguro de Daños a la Vivienda*) from \$8.00 to \$13.00 starting on the first bimonthly period of 2009
2. Enables the date entry for Suspension of Housing Credit Discounts (*Suspensión de Descuentos del Crédito de Vivienda*) for any day of the bimonthly period.
3. Corrects the calculation of a day of Amortization of Housing Credit (*Amortización de Crédito de Vivienda*) when there is a Discharge incidence after a movement regarding Suspension of Housing Credit Discounts.

Adaptations to IMSS:

1. Corrects the creation of the payment file with Complementary Contributions (*Aportaciones Complementarias*)
2. The import and manual entry of Disabilities/Leaves (*Incapacidades*) is adapted to the logic of their presentation.
3. The import of Disabilities/Leaves (*Incapacidades*) is made correctly following the criteria established for its structure and dates.

Grupo Tress Internacional has already been working on some of these adaptations and will be able to address these recent dispositions with our clients through the Annual Software Maintenance Agreement (ASMA – Póliza Anual de Mantenimiento de Software or PAMS in Spanish) with a new version of Sistema TRESS. The Sistema TRESS 2009 SUA Version will be available beginning on March 17th in order to schedule updates with clients with a valid ASMA. The Sistema TRESS 2009 SUA Version will enable our clients to:

1. Continue insuring that the information available in Sistema TRESS and SUA is the same
2. Continue automatic imports from Sistema TRESS to SUA.
3. Maintain the conciliation process between Sistema TRESS and SUA current.
4. Prepare Sistema TRESS for future anticipated changes in SUA related to data import from INFONAVIT regarding Suspension of Housing Credit Discounts.
